1. What is the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit and what does it have to do with election? See II Thessalonians 2:13; Titus 3:5

2. Apart from the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit in salvation, how else does the Father, the Son, and the Spirit work in the process of your sanctification? See I Thessalonians 5:23; Ephesians 5:26; Romans 15:16; Hebrews 9:13-14; 13:12

There is what is called “experimental sanctification” which depends on the degree of yieldedness to God, the degree of separation from sin and the degree of Christian growth. How do the following verses support this idea of sanctification? Roman 12:1; 6:22; I John 2:1-2 What other verses teach about spiritual growth and how that is possible?

There is what is called “ultimate sanctification”, which is related to the saved person’s final spiritual state. What do the following verses say about this aspect of sanctification? I John 3:2-3; I Corinthians 15:51-52

3. What is the evidence of your sanctification?
