1. From verse 38 what does it mean that Jesus came down to do the will of the One who sent Him? (See also Philippians 2:5-8; Matthew 626:39; John 3:17)

Why was it important for Jesus to be obedient to the will of the Father?

- 2. From verse 39, how is that Jesus will lose none the Father has given Him? What does that mean? Refer to verse 35; John 3:16; 5:24; I John 5:11-3; Romans 8:38-39;
- 3. The Father had a will for Jesus. He also has a will for us? According to verse 40 what is the Father's will for us? See II Peter 3:9.

What will be the result for those who follow this particular aspect of God's will? What other verses support this promise? See John 3:16; I Thessalonians 4:16-17; I Corinthians 15:51-52.

4. How does this passage encourage you to be obedient to God the Father? What steps will you take in the week ahead to do the will of God?
