If possible, read the book of John 6:35-40 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. From verse 38 what does it mean that Jesus came down to do the will of the One who sent Him? (See also Philippians 2:5-8; Matthew 6:26:39; John 3:17)

Why was it important for Jesus to be obedient to the will of the Father?

2. From verse 39, how is that Jesus will lose none the Father has given Him? What does that mean? Refer to verse 35; John 3:16; 5:24; I John 5:11-3; Romans 8:38-39;
3. The Father had a will for Jesus. He also has a will for us? According to verse 40 what is the Father's will for us? See II Peter 3:9.

What will be the result for those who follow this particular aspect of God's will? What other verses support this promise? See John 3:16; I Thessalonians 4:16-17; I Corinthians 15:51-52.

4. How does this passage encourage you to be obedient to God the Father? What steps will you take in the week ahead to do the will of God?
