If possible, read the book of I Peter 2:4-8 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to [www.studylight.org](http://www.studylight.org).

1. Read through the passage and discuss what it has to say about Jesus. Cite examples from the Gospels to support your answers. (For example, He was rejected by the people when they called for His crucifixion.)
2. What does it mean that we are “being built into a spiritual house to be a royal priesthood” and how is that made possible?
3. What spiritual sacrifices are we to offer God? (For example see Romans 12:1)
4. From verse 6-8, how is this rejected stone precious to us who believe? (1:18-19)

What is the importance of the capstone and how was this rejected stone made the capstone?

How does this stone cause those who don't believe to stumble?

5. What seems to be the point of this passage?
6. As living stones being built into a spiritual house, how should we view ourselves, other Christians, and the church as a whole? (See I Corinthians 3:9-16; Ephesians 2:19-22)
