If possible, read the book of I Peter 2:22-25 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to [www.studylight.org](http://www.studylight.org).

1. Verses 22-23 describe how Jesus endured suffering for doing good. Discuss. How is His suffering an example to you? Consider also Isaiah 53.

What are the implications for you of Jesus committing no sin? What if He had sinned? See I Corinthians 15:1-19.

Explain what it means that He “entrusted Himself to Him who judges justly.”

2. How do you die to sins through His death on the cross?

Through His death on the cross you are to live for righteousness. Discuss the application of that for your daily lives.

What does it mean that through His wounds you are healed?

3. How did Christ handle persecution? Consider Luke 23:26-46; John 18:7-11, 19-24, 28-38; 19:1-11.

4. How does this passage apply to you today? You may not be suffering for your faith currently so how can you pray for believers in other countries who are?
