Adult Impact Questions August 20, 2017

If possible, read the book of I Peter 3:12 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. Peter quotes Psalm 34:12-16. What does it mean that "the Lord's eyes are on the righteous"? What other verses imply that? (For example see Hebrews 13:5; II Chronicles 16:9)

How does that encourage you?

How does that motivate you in your daily walk? (For example see Proverbs 5:21)

2. What does it mean that "His ears are attentive to their prayers"?

That implies that His ear is not attentive at times. Suggest some reasons this may be true. (For example see Psalm 66:18) Cite other passages.

3. What does it mean that "the face of the Lord is against those who do evil"?

Give some examples from the Bible where that is evident. (For example see Proverbs 15:3)

Give some examples today where that may be evident.

- 4. Read Genesis 6:1-9; 7:5, 17-8:1 and discuss how the example of Noah and the world at that time reflects the message of this verse?
- 5. How does this verse motivate you to live righteous so that the Lord's eyes are on you and His ears attentive to your prayers?
