If possible, read the book of I Peter 3:15 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. Return to a question that was considered last week from verse 15, what question are we to be prepared to answer? Why is your answer important?

What encouragement comes from verses like Acts 1:8 and Matthew 28:18-20 as it relates to this verse? Why can't you witness in your own strength?

Share verses that speak of the hope you have and discuss the promise of this hope.

Read II Timothy 2:15 and Acts 17:11 and discuss what they suggest related to our passage and sharing the hope you have. What plan do you currently have to pursue the ideas presented in these verses?

2. What does it mean to set apart Christ as Lord in your hearts and what does setting apart Christ in your heart have to do with the previous verses and things like returning blessing for insult, not fearing intimidation, and explaining the hope that is in us?
3. How are you supposed to answer those who ask? Why? What consequences may result if you answer otherwise?
4. Discuss your plan to be prepared to share the hope that is in you.
