If possible, read the book of Psalm 126:1-6 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. Discuss the overall context of the passage. What is the Psalmist saying?

What was the response of the returning remnant?

What was the response of the surrounding nations?

How can you correlate this to your salvation and sharing the gospel?

2. Read verses 5-6 and discuss how these can apply to evangelism. What can be implied here in weeping, sowing, and harvesting?

3. Psalm 51 is David's prayer of confession. Read vs. 12-13. What is David's request in verse 12 and then his response in verse 13?

4. Matthew 28:19-20 has been deemed the Great Commission. What are your responsibilities noted in this passage? What is the promise given as you carry out the Great Commission? What other verses speak about our witnessing? Consider for example, Acts 1:8 and Romans 1:16 (Cite others).

5. What are you doing to evangelize? Make a list of those you are praying for and ask the Lord to give you a heart that weeps for them to be saved.
