2.	According to this Psalm, why is God great and worthy of praise? Discuss your findings. Cite other verses, ie. Revelation 4:11.
3.	Discuss whether or not the mighty works of God were passed on in your home? Why is that an important practice?
4.	In a Psalm that resonates with praise to God, why do you think the Psalmist interjects a verse about God being "gracious, compassionate, slow in anger and rich in love"?
5.	Share how God has demonstrated His faithfulness to you and kept His promises.
6.	What hope is found in verse 18, but what is our responsibility according to the verse?
7.	Reflect on this passage and write down what you have to praise God for.
