## Adult Impact Questions December 3, 2017

- 1. In this passage Peter shifts his focus by addressing the church leaders. What is the basis of his appeal according to verse 1? Why do you think he appeals to them in this way?
- 2. In verses 2 and 3 Peter provides an admonition of how elders are to care for the church. Some are positive and some are negative. List them categorically. Positive:

- 4. From this passage, discuss ways you can pray for the church leaders. Have someone close in prayer noting several of your closing points.
