1. What was it about the city of Jerusalem that made Jesus weep? Discuss what He must have seen, heard, or knew that aroused such a response from Him.

If Jesus road into our cities today what are things He might weep for?

2. Read verses 28-40. Referring to the other gospel accounts of the triumphal entry, who are the various peoples in the crowd. Discuss their views of Jesus.

It seems most were excited to see Jesus. What is it then, about these verses that make Jesus's response so difficult?

Who in our cities might we consider to be just like those in the crowd who lined the streets while Jesus road into town?

3. If possible, bring news articles from the local paper and share events happening in our local cities that should cause us to weep?
4. Pray this week that you might see your city through the eyes of Jesus and then list ways that you can pray.
