If possible, read II Peter 1:12-15 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. Discuss the overall meaning behind this passage.
2. What “things” does Peter want to remind his readers of?
3. What is the truth they held and why was it important to continually remind them if it was something they already held firmly?

What might cause you to question the things you hold firmly?

4. Peter spoke of his death “made clear by Christ”. Read John 21:20-23 and discuss what Peter meant in his letter about his impending death.
5. What do you suppose Peter was referring to that after his death he would make sure they would remember the things referred to in verse 12?

What has God given you to remember what He has taught? (For example see John 14:26; 16:13-14; II Timothy 3:16-17; Proverbs 27:17, Joshua 1:8; Hebrews 10:22-25.)

6. What will you do this week to help you remember what God teaches?
