If possible, read II Peter 1:19-21 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

- 1. What is the light that is shining in dark places? Why are you to take heed to it?
- 2. Read John 8:12 where Jesus says that He is the light of the world. Discuss what that means.

In that verse He also said that "whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." What did He mean? What is the light of life?

Read John 12:35-36. Is this a contradiction of what Jesus said in John 8:12? How might darkness overtake you?

- 3. Several passages in I John speak of light. Read them and discuss how they relate to Jesus and then to you as a believer. I John 1:5, 7; 2:8-10
- 4. Paul says that you are children of the light (I Thessalonians 5:5) and Peter writes that you have been brought out of darkness into His glorious light. How is that possible?
- 5. Read Matthew 5:14-16. Jesus says you are the light of the world. What does He mean? List how your light can become dim. How do you keep it bright?
- 6. What practical ways can you be a light in dark places this week?
