If possible, read Matthew 1:22-23 and John 1:1, 14 from several translations. For additional insight and study go to www.studylight.org.

1. What does it mean that “God is with us”?

Why was it necessary for God to come and literally be with us?

Read Romans 8:38-39. What encouragement is there from this passage knowing that God is with us?

2. Read John 1:1, 14 and discuss from those verses how God is with us in light of Matthew 1:22-23?

3. In what way is God with us today? Discuss John 16:5-11, 13-14.

Read Isaiah 41:10 and Hebrews 13:5. According to these passages, for what purpose is God with us in these passages?

4. We read in Matthew 28:18-20 that Jesus would be with His followers to the end of the age. Discuss what that means and the purpose for His presence.

5. How can you be encouraged today by knowing God is with us?
