1. Define harmony and then discuss what that looks like between Christ and the believer.

How is that harmony explained in the opening verses of Romans 6?

2. How does sin impair the harmony between Christ and believers? Cite other passages that suggest the impact of sin in that relationship? For example, see Psalm 66:18.
3. Why does God desire harmony?

What does it mean in verse 10 that “the life he (the Christian) lives, he lives to God?”

4. Looking at verse 13, how does a believer offer the parts of his body to sin?
5. What does Paul mean when he says we are to offer ourselves to God as instruments of righteousness? What does that look like practically for the believer?

How does that relate back to the harmony we are to have with Christ and the glory we give as His vessels?

6. If we are instruments of righteousness, how does God use that harmony to glorify Himself?
7. Why can't sin and righteousness reign simultaneously in the believer?
