1. When David refers to God's majestic name, what does 'majestic' mean and in what ways is His name majestic in all the earth?

In thinking about how majestic God is, what should be our response as we approach Him?

Discuss other passages that speak about the majesty of God's name.

2. What does it mean that God has set His "glory above the heavens?"

How is God's glory displayed in the heavens?

Discuss other passages that speak about God's glory being displayed.

3. How do little children praise the Lord and how does their praise silence the power of the enemy?

Discuss other Scriptures that refer to children offering praise to God.

4. Read Genesis 1 and discuss how the fingers of God created.

5. Why does the psalmist ask us to consider the heavens in comparison to who we are?

Think about and discuss Scripture that helps us understand why God cares for us?

6. According to verses 6-8, what responsibility has God given mankind?

7. Why did David bookend this psalm with the same thought in verse 1 and verse 9?

8. In what ways this week can you declare the majesty of God?
