Adult Impact Study Sheet – March 17, 2024

Read **Psalm 16:1-11**; if possible from several translations. For additional insight go to www.studylight.org and www.gotquestions.org.

- 1. Verses 1 and 2 "include three different names for God: Elohim (the powerful creator God), Yahweh (the covenant-giving God), and Adonai (the Lord and Master of life). David saw in all these names the personal presence of God in his life." Discuss how these names of God have impacted and continue to impact your life.
 - Elohim
 - Yahweh
 - Adonai
- 2. In the NIV, verse 1 reads, "Keep me safe, my God, for in You I take refuge." Discuss the following statement. "Safety is not felt because you have nothing to be afraid of. Rather, safety is felt because God is your protector."²
- 3. Read verse 2. "Believers need to understand that we only have one source: God. Everything else is a resource." Discuss what that means. What things in life can become a source for us, when they should only be a resource?
 - Discuss this verse in light of James 1:17 and Psalm 73:25.
- 4. Read vv. 5-6. Discuss the inheritance of the believer in contrast to the material blessings the Lord may bestow on him.
- 5. Read vv. 7-8. John 15:1-8 speaks of the necessity of abiding in Christ. Discuss what that means in light of these verses.
- 6. In the TLB (Living Bible) verse 8 reads, "I am always thinking of the Lord; and because he is so near, I never need to stumble or fall." Discuss the following. "I cannot imagine how religious persons can live satisfied without the practice of the presence of God. For my part, I keep myself retired with Him in the ... center of my soul as much as I can; and while I am so with Him I fear nothing." 4
- 7. Discuss verse 11. Consider also Proverbs 3:5-6 and 16:3
