- 7. In verse 8, David speaks of seeking the face of the Lord. What did that mean for him? What does it mean for us?
- 8. Verse 11 speaks of being led on a level path. (See also Psalm 26:11.) What does it mean to be on, to be led on, level ground?
- 9. Read verse 12. What are the adversaries of the soul?
