1. Discuss what it means for one to have the mind of Christ?
2. What does Paul state about the spirit of the world and the Spirit of God in verses 11 and 12?
3. How does Paul differentiate between the spirit of the world and the Spirit of God in verse 13?

Discuss the evidence of the Spirit of God in a person's life?

4. Read Romans 8:6-9 and 2 Corinthians 11:3

Discuss these verses in relation to the concept Paul wants to convey in verse 14.

5. In verse 15, Paul states the person with the Spirit of God makes judgements about things. Does Paul give believers the right to judge others? What is Paul's message here?
6. What is the source that a believer can access to develop our mind into the Mind of Christ?
7. From verse 16, discuss how each of us can live with the Mind of Christ each day.
