1. Read verses 1-2. What does it mean to abide what do these say about the abiding presence of God?
2. How do the following terms in these opening verses demonstrate God's almighty power and what did they do for His confidence in God? Compare these to Romans 8:37-39.

3. How is God seen in verses 3-8 as our able protector?

Describe a time when you experienced God as a shelter, refuge or fortress. How did that bolster your faith in God?

4. Read verse 9. For us to experience God's abiding presence, His almighty power, and His able protection, what must we do?

What does it mean to make God our dwelling? Cite other passages.

5. In verse 10-16, what promises are given to the person who makes God his/her dwelling and what do they mean? Does it imply that martyrs for Christ didn't have faith since they weren't protected?
6. About this Psalm, Warren Wiersbe writes: "The abiding life (vv. 1-4) produces the assuring life (vv. 5-13), the life without fear, which leads to the abounding life (vv. 14-16), the life of victory and peace." Discuss its meaning for us today.
7. What application does this psalm have for us today?
