1. How would you answer the question posed in verse 9? How does the world or other religions answer that question?

What does it mean to take heed to God's Word?

How does God's Word keep us from sin?

How does God's Word cleanse us or make us pure from sin?

What does it mean to live according to God's Word? Discuss other passages for support (For example II Timothy 3:16-17).

2. What is the psalmist's prayer in verse 10 and how does seeking God with our whole heart help a person keep pure?
3. What does it mean to hide God's Word in the heart and what is the benefit?

What is your plan for memorizing Scripture?

4. What are decrees and how does God teach them to us?

Read Deuteronomy 17:18-20 and Deuteronomy 31:9-13. Discuss who was to be read God's decrees regularly and why.

How do those passages apply to this passage in Psalm 119?

5. Besides being a deterrent to sin, according to these verses, what other benefits are there for hiding God's Word in your heart?
6. What does it mean to meditate? Discuss this in light of Psalm 1:2

Psalm 1:1 gives another reason for meditating on God's Word. What is it? How have you seen God's Word benefit you in your choice of right friends and right decisions?

7. What is the psalmist's response to God's Word?

What are ways we delight in God's Word and how do we neglect God's Word?
