1. Discuss why Paul begins His prayer the way he does in verses 14-15.
2. From this passage, share the things that Paul is praying for?
3. Paul prays that “out of God’s glorious riches,” they might be strengthened. What does “out of” mean?

What are God’s “glorious riches” from which He gives strength? Discuss this considering II Peter 1:3-4.

What does it mean that the Holy Spirit strengthens us in the “inner being?”

According to verse 17, what is the purpose of this strengthening?

4. What does it mean to be “rooted and grounded in love?” Share other verses that speak about this kind of deep love.

Read verses 18-19. Why does Paul want them to know the depth of this love?

According to verse 19, what does this love produce in the believer?

5. Reading verses 20-21, how should this shape our prayers, what is the power that works in us, and for what end (verse 21)?
